## Ticket purchase and reservation

Due to limited capacity, tickets for a desired arrival time should be purchased online in advance.

The selected 30-minute time slot will be verified at check-in. Online prices are discounted compared to a purchase at the visitor centre.

If the reservation time is missed or tickets are purchased on site, only remaining slots may be available, which will result in extended waiting times.

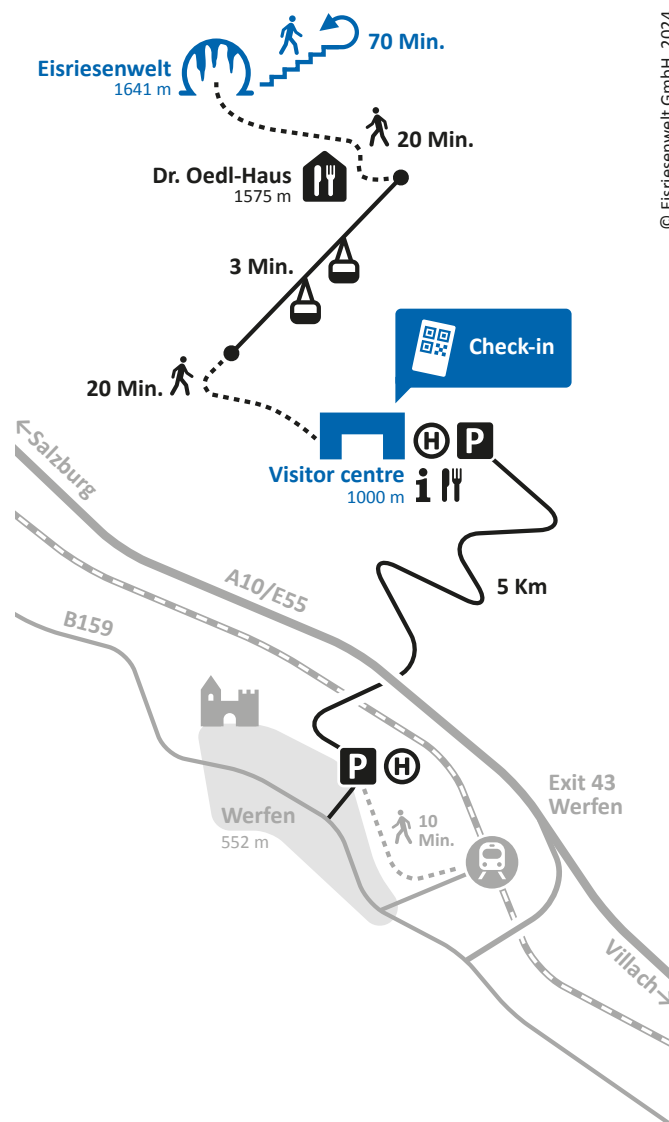
## Preparations for your visit

Heavy shoes and warm clothing are recommended. Even in summer the temperature is usually below freezing.

## Health and Fitness

Visitors have to climb 134 metres of altitude inside the cave, which is equivalent to climbing through the stairwell of a high-rise building. The beauty and breath-taking dimensions of the cave provide plenty of reward, however it is up to each visitor whether he or she is willing to make the physical effort.

Although the pace of the guided tour is tailored to the group, we advise those with serious walking difficulties or heart circulation problems not to visit the caves.



## Children

Parents must decide whether the relatively long walk and cold temperatures are suitable for their children – up to the age of three to four, the visit is often too challenging. If children accompany the group, they should be wearing warm clothing, as well as gloves and a hat.

## Weather

The caves are always well worth a visit. Good weather has the advantage of exciting panoramic views of the Salzach valley from the cave entrance and the change from light to darkness is particularly striking.

## Dogs

The Eisriesenwelt is open to animals, but a visit is not recommended due to the large number of steps.

## Photography

Please understand that filming and taking photos is not permitted inside the cave to ensure an enjoyable and undisturbed experience for all visitors.
